We have pulled needy dogs from Detroit Animal Care and Control, River Rouge Animal Shelter, Livingston Humane Society, Genesee County Animal Control, among a few others who were surrendered by their owners directly to us in 2017.

We found **Petra**, a beautiful 15-year old German Shepherd, at Detroit Animal Care and Control in October. She has horrible arthritis in her back and multiple mammary tumors that are cancerous. We were able to provide top-notch veterinary care to remove a large mammary tumor and provide meds and supplements to ease the pain of arthritis because of supporters like you.
